### **SPRING GRADUATION**



### **NGA SPOTLIGHT**



Our spotlight is on efforts by Dr. Angie Bauman, Director of Student Services at the NGA Hub, to recruit more students to study at NOBTS. Dr. Bauman conducted two college recruiting trips in the second week of April at GA Perimeter College (a four-year feeder school for the masters program at UGA) and Clayton State University, South Atlanta (72% African American student population). She hosted a group of 19 students for a BCM luncheon at GA Perimeter where four students signed up as prospects and one student is serving this summer in New Orleans through a GA Baptist BCM mission appointment. At Clayton State, 47 students attended the BCM luncheon she hosted. After conversing with several students in attendance, many of them did not profess Christ as the Son of God so the recruiting trip became more of an evangelistic message with Q & A.
