The Gays have served overseas with IMB a total of 32 years including 24 years in Latin America and 5 years in Asia.

Larry and Susan served as journeyman to Venezuela and were appointed as career

representatives living in Mexico City where they served as broadcast media consultants and in strategic leadership positions.

From 1997 to 2004 Larry was Regional Leader for the Western South America region. In 2004 he became the Personnel Associate for the Pacific Rim Region (Asia), providing leadership in the areas of training and family ministries.

Susan has served as a Member Care Consultant providing counseling, encour-

agement and training for IMB families on the field. They moved to their current assignment in November 2008.

Mike Emeott and his wife Cathy have been married for 33 years. Mike and Cathy have 4 adult children, three daughters and one son. All three daughters are married and have blessed the family with Christian son-in-laws and six wonderful grandchildren.

Both Mike and Cathy were blessed to grow up in Christian homes and invited Jesus into their lives as children.

At the age of nine after being baptized Mike remembers telling his parents that he wanted to be a preacher, unfortunately, Mike ran from

that call until age forty-nine.

Mike served God in many ways during those forty years in the wilderness, he just never surrendered to the call on his life. While serving during those forty years Mike and Cathy raised their children in a Christian home and helped them to understand the love of God and His Son.

In 1993, on a mission trip to Romania, one of thirty-five national and international mission trips Mike either led or participated in, Mike met his son. Fifteen months later, Mike and Cathy brought

their son home to America and next year (on June 30), they will celebrate his twentieth anniversary in America. Their son is no longer an abandoned eight year old, he is now a part of their family, and a part of a large faith family in Newnan.

On February 6, 2007 while on a mission trip in Honduras, Mike was involved in a tragic vehicle accident that killed three of his fellow missionaries. Mike had a severe head injury so he was airlifted out and on the first leg of the journey, in an old military helicopter, Mike believes God shared with him that it was time, no it was overtime, for him to follow his call into the fulltime vocational ministry.

In June 2007, Mike was called to the position of Executive Pastor at First Baptist Church Newnan and has served there since. In August of 2010 Mike began “sharpening his tools” by starting the process of getting an M.Div. with a specialization in Missions. This is the fourth time as an adult Mike has returned to school and he looks forward to and anticipates what God has in store for him in the second half of his life serving Him “FULLTIME.”
