## NGA Faculty Focus

Dr. Angie Bauman recently had the privilege of traveling to Cameroon, Africa along with five others to teach at Cameroon Baptist Theological Seminary. The primary purpose of the trip was to provide theological-sound and biblically-based education for the seminary students by teaching intensive week-long courses.

The team also desired to encourage the seminary faculty, staff and administration in their ministries by assisting them with much needed special projects to enhance their capacity to equip ministers to make



disciples of Jesus Christ in Cameroon and throughout all of

Africa.

What did God do while the team was in Africa? Allowed the team to:

- Train more than 250+ men and women for ministry through teaching courses
- Service 312 students, faculty and staff with free dental care
- Mentor six local pastors in personal holiness and provide pastoral training resources
- Provide resources for a Christian missionary to the Muslims in Cameroon (Amos)
- Establish wireless Internet on the seminary campus for students, faculty and staff
- Support the widows' ministry (Ma Florence leads more than 700



widows in Ndu and 6000+ widows residing in Cameroon).

This brief update does not begin to describe all that God has been doing in Cameroon and all that He did through the team, and what He is planning to do in the future, but *if the Lord wills*, Dr. Bauman hopes to travel back in **November 2013** to continue the teaching ministry and make disciples of Christ in Ndu, Cameroon, Africa.
