Each course has a tuition fee of \$50.00, payable the first day of class. In addition, there is a onetime enrollment fee of \$25.00. Each course is transferable to the undergraduate program of NOTBS, and worth one semester hour. There are no prerequisites for either of these classes and enrollment is open to any and all who wish to attend. These courses are especially beneficial for those serving in ministry positions that do not have the benefit of formal seminary training, and for lay leaders in the churches that seek to sharpen their skills. The certificate program also serves as an excellent introduction to further theological studies.

Fall semester classes are held from August 23 through December 13. Students reconvene on January 24 and continue through May 9 for the spring semester. All classes are held at East Bayou Baptist Church, 2234 Kaliste Saloom Rd, Lafayette in the Education Building, on Mondays from 4-6pm and 6-8pm
