1. The two 4x hybrid offerings will be offered from the New Orleans campus, and extension center students will be encouraged to come to campus twice for on-campus credit. Faculty will travel out to the extension center once during the semester. The trips should be well publicized so students can be in the classroom with the teacher as much as possible.
2. The hybrids starting from New Orleans will be offered with four meetings per semester of four hours each. The hybrids starting from the extension centers will be offered with eight meetings per semester of two hours each.
3. The cycle below was discontinued in the 2014-2015 year and replaced with the MTS/MACE offerings in Clinton. The graduate dean decided to keep offering the classes below without the CIV option.
