

How to change your network settings to reflect the new Wi-Fi standards.

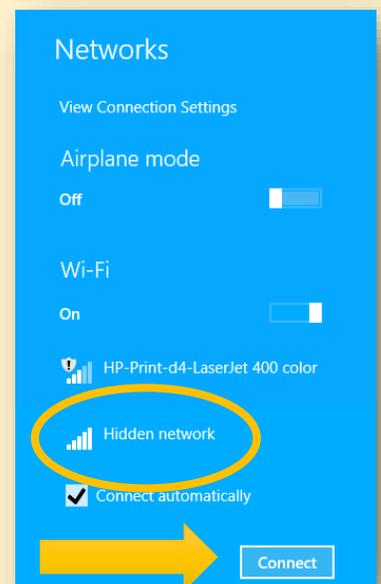
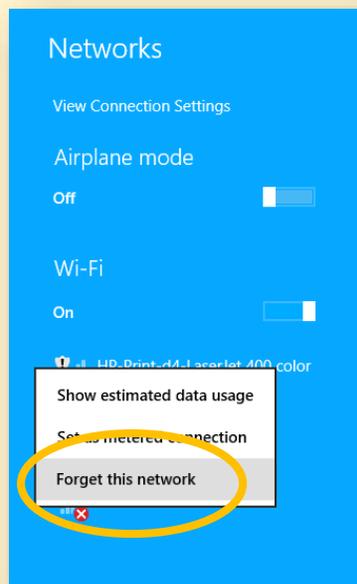
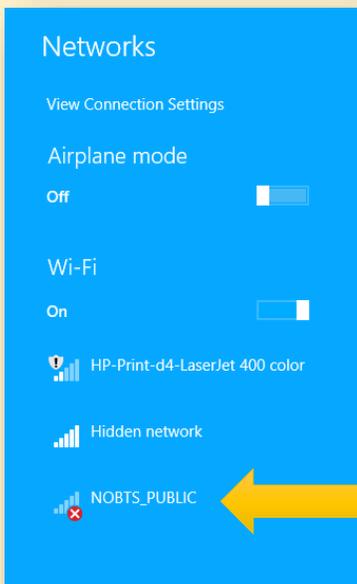

The ITC is improving our public wireless environment @ NOBTS. Part of this project includes increasing our security and connectivity standards for access to our public network.

This guide will assist you in changing your Wi-Fi connection settings to reflect the new security and connectivity requirements.

1. You will need to forget the old connection settings that no longer apply. To do this, click on the network connectivity icon on your system tray.
2. A box titled “**Networks**” will appear on the right side of your screen. Right-click on **NOBTS_PUBLIC** and select “**Forget this network**”
3. You will now see a network titled “**Hidden network**”. Select it and click “**Connect**”.



4. Type **NOBTS_PUBLIC** for the SSID name, then click “**Next**”.
5. Type **Nobts.edu/wifi** for the network security key, then click “**Next**”.
