Association for Institutional Research 2008 Grant and Fellowship Programs

The Association for Institutional Research (AIR) offers research grants for doctoral and postdoctoral study. The NCES Fellowships for Graduate Study are for graduate study advancing or leading to careers in institutional research. Fellowships will be awarded for full-time doctoral students (maximum of \$9,000 over a three year period) and part-time graduate students (maximum of \$9,000 over a three year period). The application deadline is **March 14, 2008**.

In addition to the NCES Fellowships for Graduate Study, AIR also offers Research Grants and Dissertation Fellowships. Research grants of up to \$40,000 are available to institutional researchers, faculty in all disciplines, and administrators affiliated with U.S. postsecondary institutions or governance agencies. Research projects must promise a significant contribution to the national knowledge of the nature and operation of postsecondary education. Dissertation fellowships of up to \$20,000 are available to doctoral students in all disciplines who are beginning their dissertations. Dissertations must also promise
