### *Research Proposal Approvals due May 14*


The submission deadline for research proposal approvals is **May 14, 2010**. On this date, a Research Proposal Report form indicating approval and 2 copies of the finalized document must be received by the ReDOC office. RDOC9303 Prospectus Development will be held **June 7-11**.





They should be submitted in blind-review format including a cover page with author's name, institutional affiliation, and contact information, and an abstract of no more than 100 words. Endnotes should be written in *Chicago Manual* style. Submission deadline is **August 31, 2010**
