The focus of the seminary during the 2009-10 academic year is spiritual vitality which will involve reading the entire Bible within the year.

I. Description of the Seminar This seminar is a study of the most current issues and potentially dangerous issues that are emerging in evangelism and church growth. In addition to researching the latest printed resources to discover and discuss emerging issues, attention will be given to gaining new information through the construction and implementation of surveys and other data gaining devices.

II. Objectives of the Seminar

1. Students will be able to assemble a list of the top emerging issues in evangelism and church growth and defend their selection.
2. Students will be able to thoroughly discuss the issues surrounding several emerging issues.
3. Students will develop a broad base understanding of some of the emerging issues in evangelism and church growth.
4. Students will be able to prepare an extensive bibliography of books and articles on the emerging issues studied in the seminar.
5. Students will become thoroughly familiar with a minimum of ten (10) books which are foundational in church growth from which to build expertise in emerging issues.

III. Methodology of the Seminar

1. Professor supervision: The professor will guide students in addressing the areas of study necessary to accomplish the seminar objectives.

2. Individual work: Each student will be expected to read, conduct research, and engage in critical thinking and clear writing.
3. Group discussion: Each student will be expected to participate in all seminar discussions and group discussions outside of seminar time.

IV. Requirements for the Seminar

1. **READING ASSIGNMENTS:**

A. Each student will read the five required textbooks. The textbooks are:

Written Report: Student will submit a 5-7 page (typed; double-spaced) critique: Answer at least the following.

- a. What was the author's primary purpose in writing this book?
- b. A brief summary of the book.
- c. Did the author accomplish his purpose?
- d. Complete a thorough synthesis, what were the larger messages of this book?
- e. What did you like about the book?
- f. With what did you disagree or have questions about?
- g. What are five new things you have learned from this work that you can apply in your future evangelism? (if applicable)

Due: **February 2 & 23**

B. Complete 7 hrs. of reading from various periodicals related to evangelism. Student is to prepare a short summary (2-4 pages) of the significant observations you made from you made from you reading. **(due March 2)**

2. **MAJOR PAPER:** Each student will prepare a major seminar paper related to an emerging issue in evangelism and church growth. **(due April 20, April 27, & May 04)**

Paper Particulars

One major research paper – answering a research question, topic chosen in consultation with professor

Class presentation – 1 hr. max.

Paper should develop the issue and discuss the implications on evangelism

25-35 pages approximately, high quality writing and demonstrate critical thinking skills, show the contribution to the field and cover the subject area

After completion of major paper, the paper then should be tailored to fit the publishing requirements of the Journal of the American Society for Church Growth or a similar scholarly journal or publication

Publishable and seminar paper are to both be turned in to the professor

3. **TOPICAL PAPER:** *Prepare a topical paper on an emerging issue in evangelism or church growth.*

Paper Particulars

Topic selected from professor's list or other with the professor's approval

6-8 pages

Report on emerging issues in the field of evangelism or church growth

From the paper, write 1 magazine articles fitting criteria for publication for such magazines as *Growing Churches, Discipleship Journal, On Mission, Leadership Journal*

(due 03/30 Group 1 & due 04/06 Group 2)

4. **INTERVIEWS:** *Each student will complete 7 interviews/surveys with people the student believes are not Christians or have been out of church for at least 12 years. After the interview the student is to write a thoughtful reflection of their experience. The student may want to include selected significant quotes, a summary paragraph on each interview, what you learned about people, what you discovered about yourself or what you need to learn.*

(due April 13)

Interview Guide

The student should ask for the time from the person in order to interview them for a class assignment with the objective being to simply learn how people see religious things. The purpose is not to convert the person or even share the gospel message. The purpose is to learn what people are thinking about religious matters.

Sample ask, "I am doing a class project and need your help. My assignment is to learn how people see religious things. Will you take a few minutes to help me?"

Let them know that their name will not be included in any manner. You can interview people you know, business people, people in malls or people in bars

might give you the most honest answer. Students can interview people in the French Quarter, but do not interview street people. Also, please do not interview family members for this class assignment.

Take the approach of a student researching, not a minister evangelizing. Please do not try to convince them or to debate with them; simply record their answers on a notepad. If they ask your opinion, gracefully decline (because you do not want to influence their answer). *After* the interview, if the person asks you to tell them your beliefs, listen to the Holy Spirit and 1) either set another time to get together for that purpose or 2) go ahead and share. THE POINT, if they feel you are conning them into a witnessing opportunity, you will not get their true feelings and thoughts.

The following represent questions the student should ask...

To you, what is God like? Describe God.

If they don't believe in God, don't ask the next to God questions, but ask:

To you, what is important in life? & then skip question 4

How would you describe your religious background and church involvement if any?

What do you think it takes to be straightened out with God?

Describe what the term Jesus Christ means to you.

From your perspective, what are the major problems of churches today?

5. ZERO BAPTISM CHURCH INTERVIEW. Each student will interview the pastor of a church which reported zero baptisms for several years and then experienced a significant increase in baptisms. A five page report will prepared for each member of the class. The report should include historical setting for the church, significant evangelistic actions, and any barriers that had to be overcome.

6. BIBLE READING PLAN: Each student is expected to participate in the NOBTS Bible Reading Plan for the Spring 2010 semester. The student will submit a report regarding the percentage of the assigned Scripture that was read during the semester.

V. Evaluation

The final grade will be determined by the professor's evaluation of the student's written work and oral presentations, taking into account style, critical thinking, design, subject coverage and other related matters.
